What is the average attendance at your events?	For salsa socials, about 200-300 student and community members. At the workshops weekender event hosted this past year, we had about 200 attendees each day for a Friday, Saturday and Sunday event.
Why are you requesting Annual Grants?	We are a very active group that performs and competes at Stanford and around California. We work really hard to improve, and a great way to do that is by attending Salsa Congresses - which are skills and things that we also use to be able to bring back to the community when we teach workshops. We need money to support our travel and registration for these events, as well as costumes for our performances, and additional expenses such as food for our group bonding events. What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?	<p>1) Registration Expenses: This is to register for events where we perform (Viennese Ball), compete (LA College Salsa Congress), where we take workshops that we then use to guide our own workshops and bring back for our salsa socials (Reno Latin Dance Festival)</p> <p>2) Accommodations: Accommodations for our trip to the LA College Salsa Congress where the team competes; accommodations for performance tour where we have a series of performances and also take workshops that (similarly as above) use for workshops that are then used to guide salsa social workshops</p> <p>3) Travel Fares: Taken the increase of FLI students within the group, we aim to give members financial aid so that they are able to make it to our performances (performance tour) and competition (LA College Salsa Congress), and any Congress where the team takes workshops to be able to improve (Reno Latin Salsa Congress) and subsequently be ready to teach at salsa socials</p>
