What is the average attendance at your events?	At staff meetings we generally have about 30 SHPRC staffers. For events that are open to the wider Stanford community, we expect our staff to attend, as well as anywhere from an additional 10 to 40 community members, depending on the type of event.
Have you applied for Annual Grants in the past 3 years? If so, please detail the outcome of each attempt.	Yes, we have, and we have received funding every year.
What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford community?	Throughout the academic year we maintain an office where we sell subsidized safer sex products like condoms, lube, sex toys, and more. We also invite speakers to host workshops, perform, give talks, and much more. As counselors we hold outreaches in dorms and other community spaces where we discuss sexual health-related topics. Our office is open during the week for students to come and purchase sexual health products and also seek peer counseling from our staff.
What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?	Our largest line items are equipment, honoraria, and event food. Keeping our office well-stocked (equipment) requires a significant amount of money due to the amount of students that access our services and also the extremely generous rate of our subsidies. Having a large honoraria budget allows us to invite many speakers, including artists and sexual health professionals, who can provide Stanford students with information and experiences that we as students cannot provide ourselves. The event food budget allows us to plan events during times of day that students will most likely be free to attend (lunch and dinner) and also gives them a reason to come, besides our excellent programming.
Why are you requesting Annual Grants?	For decades now SHPRC has been an integral part of the Stanford community, and our mission of providing universal and affordable sexual health products, education, counseling, and more, is an essential part of campus life. Our services benefit all undergraduate students.
