What is the average attendance at your events?	Varies. Brunches get 50 people, shabbat dinners get 100 people, Jewish Special Dinner gets 200. Regular meetings are 15 people, and Jewfro meetings are 20 people.
Why are you requesting Annual Grants?	To fund these events and have a strong Jewish Community on campus. To be able to celebrate Jewish holidays and our Jewish heritage.
What are the three largest line item requests in your budget and why?	Food. We need significant funding for food because of the various Jewish holidays and the fact that we co-sponsor meals with Hillel (almost every meal at Hillel is cosponsored with JSA). Additionally, kosher food is very expensive so we need more than what is usually provided for food. We try to have food at every one of our events because it really brings people together. Apart from the food, we need supplies, such as plates, cups, and decorative items to decorate our events and give them the appropriate ambiance, from Hannukah to JSD theme to Purim and Sukkot, a Sukkah requires heavy lifting and ends up being expensive. Finally, we do need some funding for facilities rental since we do not own a space and do our events at places we usually need to pay for. Particularly JSD and the retreats require facility rental funding.
What events/programs does your group hold throughout the year for the Stanford community?	Brunches are open to everyone, we try to host speakers that are in any way related to Israel or Judaism. Shabbat dinners at Hillel
